- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe, protected and healthy environment.
- I will support my coaches and officials in working with my child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at ALL youth sporting events.
- I WILL REMEMBER THE GAME IS FOR THE YOUTH...NOT ADULTS
- I will make youth sports fun for my child and teach them that teamwork, participation and doing your best are more important than winning.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I promise to help my child enjoy youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.
- I promise not to make this a babysitting service for my child and agree to get my child to practice on time and to pick up after practice on time.
- I promise to remember that the children participate for enjoyment and desire of the game.
- I will applaud both teams and encourage my team and child even when they make mistakes.
- I will encourage my child to improve skills and to use good sportsmanship
- I know that physical and verbal abuse toward ones self or another have no place in youth sports and is unacceptable at any level.
- I will not ridicule or yell at my child or any child for making a mistake or not living up to my expectations
- I will not be confrontational with any official, coach or league representative and will refer all my concerns to the Recreation Department.
- I am aware that many of our youth officials started by playing in our leagues and someday my child may be an official in our program, and will treat all officials the way I would treat my own child.
- As a parent of a child participating in the Jackson Recreation Department youth activity, I will help make our community the model program for all youth sports throughout the country to follow.
