



## **The Draft City of Jackson Recreation Plan Public Comment Period and Public Hearing**

Every five years the City of Jackson Parks and Recreation Commission conducts a comprehensive planning process to develop a master plan for its parks and recreation system. The recreation plan is used as an overall guide to develop and operate the City's parks, trails, recreation facilities, and recreation programming. The City of Jackson Parks and Recreation Commission is seeking citizen input on the draft plan prior to its formal adoption. **The proposed recreation plan is available for comment between Sunday, December 3, 2023, and Wednesday, January 3, 2024**, on the City's website ([www.cityofjackson.org](http://www.cityofjackson.org)), in the office of the Department of Parks, Recreation, Cemeteries, & Trails located on the 5th floor of City Hall (161 W. Michigan Ave.), at the Boos Recreation Center in Loomis Park, at the MLK Recreation Center in the Howard Woods Recreation Complex, or at the Carnegie Branch (244 W. Michigan Ave) or Meijer Branch (2699 Airport Rd.) of the Jackson District Library.
