

# EYES ON THE BLOCK

**Eyes on the Block** is a voluntary Community Safety Ring Doorbell Camera Program designed to help deter and solve violent crime while protecting resident privacy. This is **not a surveillance program** and cameras are **not monitored by law enforcement**. Cameras are resident-owned, and the Jackson Police Department does not have automatic access to footage. If an incident occurs nearby, residents may receive a request to share a video clip. **Residents can choose to help by sharing footage**, or ignore the request and remain private. If a request is ignored, law enforcement will not know, and participation remains anonymous.



## YOU STAY IN CONTROL

Resident-owned cameras. No automatic police access. You decide what is shared.



## NOT SURVEILLANCE

Not monitored by law enforcement. Not mandatory. Built for safety with privacy protections.



## TAKE ACTION FOR SAFETY

Help deter crime without giving up your privacy. You choose what happens next.
