Jackson Recreation Department ADULT SOCCER LEAGUE INFORMATION

(30 and Over COED, Women players can be 25 & Older), Non Premier COED)

- 1. Teams must carry a minimum of 14 players and maximum of 24.
- 2. All teams must turn in a player roster sheet and pay their team fee on or before June 11, 2019 before they are eligible to play. Team fee must be paid at the Jackson Recreation Department, 5th floor of City Hall. Any violation will result in a forfeit by the offending team.
- 3. No player may be added to your roster after Friday, July 5, 2019. Players in Non-premier COED leagues must be at least 18 years of age or a high school graduate. Players for the 30 and over league must turn 30 on or before August 31 of the current year to be eligible. Exception, women players must be 25 on or before August 31 of the current year to be eligible. All players must live in Jackson County or bordering counties unless otherwise approved by league director.

Non-premier players may play in the 30 and over co-ed if they meet age requirements. Coed teams must have no less than 3 women on the field of play during the duration of the game. If a female cannot continue play and no substitute is available their team can play on with ten players (no additional male player may be added). At no time can a coed team drop to less than 2 females on the field at any time.

4. Each team scheduled for the 6:00 game will be responsible for putting up and taking down (if theirs is the only game scheduled for that field) one goal net and two corner flags, and returning them to the soccer shed. If a team has a 7:30 game scheduled, each team will be responsible for taking down a goal net and two corner flags and returning them to the soccer shed.

GAME SCHEDULE/STARTING TIME:

GAMES:	Beginning week of June 11

GAME TIME: The referee will begin a game clock at 6:00 p.m. At 6:10 p.m. it will be a forfeit if less than 7

players appear. For the second game, 7:30 and 7:40-forfeit.

LENGTH OF GAME: Length of Game will be two 35-minute periods. It will be stopped only in the case of suspension

or special circumstances as deemed by the referee.

Jackson Recreation Department 2019 ADULT SOCCER LEAGUE LAWS

LAWS:

The Jackson Recreation Department will follow the F.I.F.A. Laws, unless changed below, as our guidelines for league play.

- 1. Unlimited Substitutions will be allowed.
- 2. Shin guards are required for all Jackson Recreation Department Leagues.
- 3. Game balls will be supplied by each home team for the game.

It is also their decision that the referees must be given a fair chance to do their job and that no player will be allowed to interfere with their calls or play of the game. Abusive, obnoxious players will not be tolerated. If they attempt to persist in making a remark that is derogatory about a call, referee, coach or player, they will be warned by the referee with a yellow card and secondly will be red carded.

THE JACKSON RECREATION DEPARTMENT CONSIDERS ALL ADULT LEAGUES AS FAMILY EVENTS. ANY PROFANITY OR OBSCENE GESTURES TOWARD ONES SELF OR OTHERS WILL BE CHECKED WITH A YELLOW CARD.

Player Ejection

- 1. A. Two yellow cards in a single game, the player will be ejected from the game, with a no game suspension.
 - B. Two yellow cards in a second game, the player will be ejected from the game, and suspended for the following two games.
 - C. Two yellow cards in a third game, the player will be ejected from the game, and must be approved by the Review Committee, after a player hearing for reinstatement.
- 2. A. One red card of a nonviolent nature will be ejection from the game and a one game suspension.
 - B. A second red card of a nonviolent nature will be ejection from the game and the player must be approved by the Review Committee, after a player hearing for reinstatement.
 - C. A third red card for a non violent nature and the player will be suspended for the remainder of the season, and must be approved by the Review Committee, after a player hearing for reinstatement into the league for eligibility for the next season.
- 3. A. One red card for a violent (physical contact, such as swinging at or hitting a player or referee) will result in ejection from the game, the player will be suspended indefinitely, and must be approved by the Review Committee, after a player hearing, for reinstatement.

Team managers or designated team captains will at all times be responsible for the behavior and actions of all players and spectators. Team managers and captains may be red carded if an official deems necessary. All teams must have player roster sheets completed and handed into a referee at the beginning of each game. An ejected player will have three minutes to leave the playing area of the field. If they fail to do so, the game will be terminated and will be recorded as a forfeit by the offending team.

A Review Committee of the League Director, the Recreation Superintendent, a representative of the Referee's Association and two players' representatives will make the decision on reinstatement and/or expulsion from the league. Each team will designate one of its players as a player representative. If the Review Committee convenes, it will randomly draw two player representatives, excluding the offending team.
