ENTRY FEE & UMPIRE FEE

With your entry fee, each team will be registered with USA Softball of Michigan, along with a scorebook and rule book. Since the umpires are not on payroll with the Recreation Dept., they are considered independent contractors. The USA SOM will cover the insurance for each umpire and team that is registered.

PLAYER FEES:

On your official team roster sheet, there are three columns designating City Resident, City Supporter, and Non-Resident. Managers are to check the appropriate column accordingly.

EXPLANATION:

\$12.00 City Residents live in the City of Jackson

\$16.00 City Supporters include people who work in the City and pay ½% income tax

\$24.00 Non-Residents are those people who don't live and/or work within the city limit

PLAYERS FEES MUST BE PAID WHEN TURNING IN ROSTER SHEETS, AND ENTRY FEES. TEAMS WILL NOT BE SCHEDULED UNTIL ENTRY FEES AND PLAYER FEES ARE PAID.

NOTE: Roster sheets are the responsibility of the manager and **MUST BE SIGNED** by each player before participating in the softball program.

The Recreation Department reserves the right to make random checks of players I.D. to establish that they are city residents or supporters.

FIELD RESERVATIONS:

1. Reservation weeks begin on Monday and go thru Sunday. You must come to the Recreation Office between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday to reserve a practice field for that week or fields may be reserved on Friday for the following week. **NO PHONE RESERVATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** There will be a \$5 fee per hour for use of practice field.
2. Each team may reserve a field twice a week. Reservations will be taken on the hour only, i.e. 6:00, 7:00, 8:00. . .

Every effort will be made to make up rain out games on your league night. If there is not a way to make up a game on your normal league night, we may have to make up on a Friday. The rainout line is 517-788-4690.

STORM POLICY:

If thunder and lightning are observed or dark clouds are approaching, our umpires have been instructed to stop play and advise everyone involved to seek shelter until playable conditions return. The safest places are a sturdy building or a car. Stay away from metal sheds or under trees. Remember that NO ball game is important enough to risk the danger of being struck by lightning. We can always resume games at a later time.

- Uniforms:** Please make sure each team member has a matching jersey. The Recreation Department **NO LONGER** takes shirt orders. You can go with any company you wish.
- USA Registration:** With your entry fee, you will be registered with USA Softball of Michigan. Each team will receive a Rules Book and Scorebook.
