Proposed Substantial Amendment #4 to the
2019-2020 Annual Action Plan

Notice is hereby given by the City of Jackson that a proposed Substantial Amendment #4 to the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan has been prepared by the Department of Neighborhood & Economic Operations. The proposed amendment involves a supplemental allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus (CDBG-CV grants).

The proposed use will increase Community Action Agency's budgets for Foreclosure Prevention and Administration as follows:
