

**Public Notice**  
**Proposed Substantial Amendment to the**  
**2021-2022 Annual Action Plan**

Notice is hereby given that the Jackson City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday October 26, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. on the second floor of City Hall, 161 West Michigan Avenue, Jackson, Michigan. The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public an opportunity to comment on the proposed Substantial Amendment 1 to the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan. The Annual Action Plan identifies the projects and activities the City of Jackson funded with Community Development Block Grant and HOME funds between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022. The proposed Substantial Amendment 1 will reprogram \$200,000 HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funds toward the new Partnership Park Homebuyer Rehabilitation activity.

In order to be in compliance with HUD regulations, the City must establish a 30-day comment period which will begin September 29, 2021 and end October 31, 2021.
